Fifth Meeting of the Regional Working Group for the Fisheries Component Shanghai, China, 23-25 September 2008

2008 Completed and On-going Activities Of the Fisheries Component

1. Fisheries Component-relevant activities completed during the past year and those still ongoing are described below.

Agenda 5.1 Joint Regional Stock Assessment

- 2. During the 1st Stock Assessment Workshop (SAW) in Qingdao (14-16 April 2008) participants reached agreement on the protocol of the 1st Joint Regional Stock Assessment. The surveys of 1st Joint Regional Stock Assessment were completed by the end of May. Using samples from the surveys an expert exchange was undertaken to harmonize ageing and stomach contents analysis (this will be discussed in more detail in the next agenda item). The 2nd SAW was conducted in Incheon (19-21 August 2008) and some initial results were discussed and protocol set for the 2nd joint Regional Stock assessment.
- 3. The final report is not due until after the 3rd Stock Assessment Workshop in 2009, however, Dr. Jin and Dr. Yeon will report on the progress of the stock assessment activity.

Participants should consider how to improve the potential benefits to the understanding of Yellow Sea Fish Stocks.

Agenda 5.2

Expert Exchange and Harmonisation of Ageing and Stomach Contents Analysis.

- 4. Experts from ROK travelled to China to conduct harmonisation of stomach contents analysis, the results will be presented by ROK scientists. Experts also travelled from China to ROK for harmonising the ageing techniques of fish using otoliths, one of these Chinese scientists will be invited to give talks.
- 5. The 2nd SAW agreed that no further activities were required.
