Fisheries Component Activities for 2008 and Onwards

- 1. During the past three years of Project Implementation, members of the RWG-F have provided technical guidance for implementation of activities under this component. All activities that have been identified for implementation during the first three years of the Project have been implemented. The exception being the cruise.
- 2. While Agenda 6 will focus on the main activities over the next two years that will contribute to the Strategic Action Programme (SAP), Agenda 7 will consider other activities that may not directly contribute to SAP, but are needed for enhancing cooperation and capacity building in the region.

Agenda 7.2.1 Co-operative study cruise

3. The Cruise listed under this Agenda has already been presented to the Regional Scientific and Technical Panel and the Project Steering Committee, and has been approved for implementation. Technical and logistic arrangements for the Biodiversity Component of the Cruises have already been discussed. The Secretariat will update the Meeting on the progress of this activity, if any.

- 5. Regional Fisheries and Ecosystem Management/Implementation Plans
 - Implementation of the regional stock assessment guidelines
 - Fish larval survey could be added to the co-operative cruise
 - Implementation of EBFM or ITQ
 - Members suggestions

- To implement the regional early warning system for prevention of disease outbreaks
