Expected Outputs from the 5th RWG-P Meeting

After nearly four years of implementation, the UNDP/GEF Yellow Sea Project has completed its first two major outputs, the Transboundary Diagnostic Analysis (TDA), and the final draft of the Regional Strategic Action Programme (SAP). The PSC agreed to submit the final draft to the participating countries for final endorsement of the governments.

At the Fifth Regional Working Group – Pollution (RWG-P) Meeting, members and participants will:

- review the completed and on-going activities under the Pollution Component from 2008 to 2009;
- suggest activities required to implement the SAP management actions to help draft the 2nd Phase Project Document; and
- keeping in mind the winding down of the project and little remaining funds, discuss and agree on future activities to implement;
